Section 3: Supplemental (non-Vacancy Specific) Recruitment Activities Undertaken

During the 2021-2022 reporting period, the station's EEO outreach continued to be limited due to the ongoing pandemic, which has hit Michigan particularly hard. The station was, however, able to participate in scholarship programs, undertake internal training, and conduct other outreach activities. As noted below, through his family foundation, the station's principal owner endowed two Michigan Association of Broadcasters scholarships.

Internship Program: WBKB-TV has an ongoing internship program and accepts internships whenever possible. The station works with Alpena Community College, Ferris State University, Grand Valley State and other area schools to solicit student participation in the program. During the period covered by this report, the station hired Oliver Moster as a News Intern.

Training: The station conducts periodic training for the sales staff through Local Broadcast Sales, Pulse Research, and the Michigan Association of Broadcasters. Additionally, on-air staff underwent on-air presentation performance training sessions.

Knowledge Bowl: WBKB annually runs a Knowledge Bowl for area high schools. This year, Knowledge bowl aired from 10/4/2021-4/8/2022. Knowledge Bowl was created, produced and aired during the reporting period. There were 14 area high schools involved. It was moderated by Alpena Community College professor Karol Wolchak. The top four teams received trophies. As these programs are taped in the studio, students participating in the Knowledge Bowl see the studio facilities of the station and are exposed to the technical aspects of setting up this locally produced program.

Job Fairs: Alpena High School hosted their first Career and Industry night Tuesday, 4/12/22. Students were welcome to visit the many booths setup around the hallways with representatives from a various number of career paths and companies. New Director Kevin Hodge represented WBKB and answered questions from students about working in the news field. Reporter Erin Griffin was also present and filmed a story on the event which aired on that day's 11PM newscast.

Scholarships: The licensee's sole shareholder has endowed two scholarship programs for students interested in a broadcast career. These scholarships are administered through the Michigan Association of Broadcasters. This shareholder is the current chair of the Association's Board of Directors.
